Public Notice of Approval for Special Procurement REQ-DASOBO-00204874

The State of Oregon, acting by and through its Oregon Department of Human Services (ODHS), hereby provides public notice of the approval of Special Procurement REQ-DASOBO-00204874 to amend ODHS Contract 185005 (OregonBuys PO-10000-00043781). This extension will allow for: expansion of pre-determined services to accommodate the Transformation Project’s close-out (the Work funded by the Contract); increase the NTE to \$6,576,064; and extend the term to June 30, 2027.

This is not an opportunity to submit a proposal. This notice is pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 279B.085 (5) and 279B.400, and Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) 125-247-0287, 125-247-0700 and 137-047-0700. Any affected person may protest the approval of the Special Procurement.

An affected person must deliver a written protest to the State Chief Procurement Officer within seven (7) calendar days after the first date of this public notice.

The written protest must include:

1. A detailed statement of the legal and factual grounds for the protest;
2. A description of the resulting harm to the affected person; and
3. The relief requested.

A protest must be clearly labeled and include the Special Procurement number. Protests must be delivered to the **State Chief Procurement Officer** within the seven (7) calendar days by mail or email at the following:
