Please be advised of the following changes to the above-mentioned solicitation:

I. Questions and Answers:

The following are questions received from Vendors and responses from Illinois Tollway pursuant to the question and answer portion of the above-mentioned solicitation. The Illinois Tollway has provided its answers accordingly.

1. **Question:** Government point of contact Name, Email and Phone.
Answer: Refer to BidBuy for Info Contact details.
2. **Question:** Do I have to be registered with the Board of Elections prior to bid submission?
Answer: Yes, State Board of Elections requirement: Any Offeror with bids/proposals, including this submission, or current contracts totaling over \$50,000.00 must be registered with the Board of elections <https://www.elections.il.gov/>
3. **Question:** Do I need to be registered with the Secretary of State if I am registered in my own State?
Answer: Offeror must be legal entity at time of submission but must be registered with the Secretary of State for Illinois prior to contract execution, unless Offeror is exempt under Business Contracts Act.

4. **Question:** Do I need to have an IDHR number?
Answer: Yes, Offeror must have the IDHR # if firm has 15 or more employees.

6. **Question:** This bid specification appears to call for a single engine street sweeper. Bid # 25-0074 that was due in November 2025 was cancelled. We were under the impression that the bid was cancelled because the Tollway intended to specify a dual engine machine in lieu of single engine. The spec included with this re-bid # 25-0074R is again written to allow for a single engine configuration. Please advise if the Tollway intends to purchase single or two engine street sweepers.

Answer: The sweeper specification calls for an engine driven hydraulic pump system. The truck chassis can be driven by an additional engine or a single engine as long as the hydraulic pump system is driven by an engine not a Power Take Off (PTO).
