**Question 1:** The quotation form appears to require a single lump-sum price. However, Item 5 of the Scope of Work identifies Priority 1, Priority 2, and Priority 3 work areas. Would you like respondents to submit one lump-sum quotation for the entire project, or would you prefer separate pricing for each priority area?

**Response: Submit separate pricing for each priority area. Use revised quotation form in Addendum NO.2**

**Question 2:** The specifications require removal and disposal of the existing degraded mulch. Is there a Town of Granby or Granby Public Schools location where the material may be hauled and legally disposed of, or should contractors include off-site disposal costs within their quotation?

**Response: Change to the scope of work, do not remove or excavate existing mulch. Re-grade existing mulch in preparation of adding to a total depth of twelve (12) inches of mulch.**

**Question 3:** Would you prefer the quote structured as a single bundled price, or broken out separately by priority (Priority 1, 2, and 3)?

**Response: Submit separate pricing for each priority area. Use revised quotation form in Addendum NO.2**

**Question 4:** Are the sites number 1-6 in my photo all the sites for the entirety of the bid?

**Response:** Two slides are missing from the picture. See the picture below for the identified areas to receive mulch.

Priority 1 - Red

Priority 2 - Red and Green

Priority 3 - Red, Green, and Blue



**Question 5:** [C]ould you please confirm that a 50% bid bond is in fact required if the contract is more than \$25,000 or does it not apply to this contract?

**Response: Fifty Percent (50%) Bond Payment required if contract is more than \$25,000.**
