

Invitation to Bid
“Purchase of Diesel Fuel”

The City of Quincy, acting through the Department of Public Works, is soliciting bids for the purchase and delivery of approximately 78,000 gallons of diesel fuel per year at approximately 6,500 gallons per month. All diesel fuel deliveries shall be made to the Department of Public Works Fuel Island located at One Sea Street, Quincy, MA 02169. (Just off to the right of the New Public Safety Headquarters Building.)

All delivery trucks shall have accepted Massachusetts Calibrated Tanks. Only deliveries made with Massachusetts calibrated tanks on the truck will be acceptable and approved for payment. All bids of diesel fuel regarding sulfur content MUST conform with the regulations of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and all its subdivisions.

Bids must state exceptions, if any, and the estimated delivery date. Bids must be in a sealed envelope. The outside of the sealed envelope is to be clearly marked "**Purchase of Diesel Fuel**" with time/date of bid call.

Bids will be received at the Office of the Purchasing Department; City Hall; 1305 Hancock Street; Quincy, MA 02169, until **Thursday, July 14, 2026, at 11:00 a.m.**

Firm bid prices will be given first consideration. Bids will be received at the Office of the Purchasing Department until the time and date stated above, at which time and date they will be publicly opened and read. Late Bids delivered by mail or in person will be rejected.
