**“Surplus Used Docks at Town River Marina”**

The City of Quincy, acting through the Department of Natural Resources, is soliciting sealed bids for the sale of used floating dock systems currently located at the Town River Marina (TRM), 666–674 Southern Artery, Quincy, Massachusetts 02169. TRM is owned and operated by the City of Quincy and serves as a public marina facility for Quincy residents to store and launch recreational vessels. As part of ongoing improvements, new floating docks have been installed for the 2026 season, rendering the existing docks surplus to municipal needs.

The City of Quincy is offering the surplus docks for sale to the highest responsible and responsive bidder. The approved buyer shall assume full responsibility for the removal, disassembly (if required), and transportation of the dock systems from the marina site within 30 days of notice of award. All work must be completed in accordance with applicable safety, environmental, and local regulatory requirements. The dock systems are sold as-is, where-is, and the successful bidder is responsible for all removal and transportation. The dock systems are offered in used condition and may exhibit wear consistent with prior use.

Inspection of the docks will be allowed at the Town River Marina Monday through Friday 9am – 3:30 pm during the bidding period. Docks are located in the lower parking lot of the marina.

Bids will be received at the Office of the Purchasing Department; City Hall; 1305 Hancock Street; Quincy, MA 02169, until **Thursday, July 23, 2026, at 11:00 a.m.**
